





- Skin care layer full of hydrocolloids focused on absorbing sweat, oil, and moisture from the skin around the stoma
- Protection layer with more polymers for strength and structure provides structural integrity to remove in one piece, and protect the skin underneath
- **Elastic topfilm –** enables the barrier to stretch, bend, and follow body movements







The curved star-shaped barrier has petals that hug the body with less creasing or folding.


Fit zones in the center and outer rim of the barrier increase flexibility right around the stoma and optimize fit and flexibility for movement.



A built-in stability ring stabilizes the center zone so the stoma gets the necessary support.


- If your patient is between two barrier sizes, choose the smallest one.



Common fit challenge

Some of the fit challenges for users with inward body profiles are:

- Stoma openings are commonly flush with or below skin surface¹
- \bullet High risk of leakage (84%) $\!^{\!\scriptscriptstyle 1}$
- Traditional convex barriers can feel bulky and stiff²








Challenge

Premature babies should be disturbed as little as possible.





- The soft flange is designed for gentle application of the pouch with little pressure on the abdomen.
- The elastic adhesive balances the pH level of the skin and fits the contours of premature babies.
- The barrier has no starter hole and can be customized to accommodate two stomas.
