COVID-19?

In the first quarter of 2020, our major funding source, a family foundation which provided our basic operational funding for the past three years, notified us that their board of directors voted to provide funding only to hospitals, which were in extreme financial distress due to the virus.

We have managed to raise funds to continue operations through December 31, 2020. That leaves us without operating income for 2021. We are in need of a new source(s) of financial support in order to continue providing services to patients and educating nurses in ostomy care.





Ostomy Care Hints

Don't be afraid to take a shower with your pouching system off. Use gentle water pressure and avoid hard water pressure spraying directly on the stoma. Pulsating or forceful shower spray could cause some bleeding, so is best to stand with your back to the spray of the shower. Soap and shampoo won't hurt your stoma, just be sure to rinse very thoroughly at the end of your shower. Be prepared, and have something available to catch drips from a urostomy or ileostomy after the shower. Some people use a clean, dry washcloth or small towel, gauze or paper towels to absorb any flow from the stoma while drying off and getting ready to place a new pouch.
